INSPECTION REPORTS

Mayor James Eves- Sewer Treatment Plant – The EFC is requesting a bigger Disinfection system that is not needed. If required we may have to raise Sewer rates. Currently, the Village does not dump any excess sewage into the Black River. Everything stems upstream from Watertown and beyond.

Trustee Mike Lane - Equipment- Lawnmower to be purchased.

Trustee Bruce Nutting - Water Plant – Nothing to report.

Trustee Richard Stevenson - Streets, sidewalks and ditches – 7 Trees have been cut around the village as needed. A Complaint about the sidewalk in front of the parking lot next to the Diner will be addressed pavement will be done instead of the sidewalk as soon as possible.

Trustee Renee Stano - Buildings & grounds – Patti Hallett complained about the water connection. The antennae was buried. Twice the DPW had to dig it up she did not realize that very few people have a meter pit. The installation of the meter pit was done by the contractor. He did not contact the village for any information on depth. She understood after the explanation was given.
